Course Overview	JA1 is a class for super-beginner level international students with no prior Japanese. The first half of the course is for learning hiragana and katakana. The second half of the course is for learning Japanese grammar, vocabulary and expressions according to beginner-level texts, and improving speaking skills by using them. Kanji are gradually introduced from Lesson 3 of the text.		
Course Objectives	The course aims to have students acquire the following abilities: (1) Writing and Pronunciation of Hiragana and Katakana correctly. (2) Vocabulary based on the progression of the texts. (3) Grammar skills based on the progression of the texts.		
Prerequisite	There are no prerequisites for this course. Preparing in advance or reviewing what you have learned will ease the learning.
